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1. Purpose of the Meeting

The Chair opened the meeting and explained that it had been convened following the recent election of Natalie Lindsay as a Councillor for the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham. The purpose of the meeting was to consider whether her new public office could give rise to any actual or perceived conflict of interest in relation to her role as Secretary and member of the WBRA Management Committee.

2. Resignation from the Management Committee

Following discussion of the agenda item, Natalie Lindsay declared her interest in the matter. Natalie took no part in the Committee's decision.

The remaining members of the Management Committee considered the matter and agreed that, in order to avoid any potential future conflict of interest, or perception thereof, it was advisable for Natalie Lindsay to step down from her position as Secretary and resign from the Management Committee with immediate effect.

The Committee recorded its sincere thanks to Natalie for her significant contribution to the WBRA and the local community over the past five years and wished her every success in her new role as a Councillor.

It was noted that Natalie will continue to be a member of the WBRA in her capacity as a local resident but will no longer serve on the Management Committee or exercise any Management Committee voting rights.

3. Appointment of Secretary

The Committee unanimously nominated and appointed Clare Hey, of the Management Committee, as Secretary of the Wandsworth Bridge Road Association with immediate effect.

4. Closing Remarks

The Committee reaffirmed its commitment to continuing its work on behalf of the local community and businesses, supporting a Wandsworth Bridge Road that is thriving, safe and sustainable and that benefits everyone in the community.

There being no further business, the Chair thanked those present for attending and declared the meeting closed.
